# BERKS COUNTY BICYCLE CLUB RIDES

First Number: Terrain Rating Terrain rating 1-5 rates the total hilliness of the ride.

1 = FLAT-easiest

2= GENTLY ROLLING HILLS-moderate terrain with easiest of hills (Almost anyone can handle).

3= SOME HILLS-Moderate hills with some steeper grades (Moderately Challengingbut within the ability of most riders). **4= HILLY–**The number and difficulty of hills is quite substantial (Very Challenging). 5= EXTREMELY HILLY-Extreme Challengesteep and long hills most of the ride. Requires a very high fitness level).

Second Number: Total Mileage for ride

Please note the Club policy on protective headgear: ALL Riders must wear Snell/ANSI rated helmets. Ride Host/ Hostess will NOT give cue sheets to riders without helmets and that rider will not be considered an official participant of the Club ride.

Please have your bike in proper working order BEFORE the start of ride. Arrive 10-15 minutes before start time so that all rides leave on time. Bring a spare tube or patch kit, and at least one water bottle.

If weather conditions are questionable, the ride host may notify club members by postor make a decision at the starting location based on road conditions and the weather forecast.

### **Updates**

President Randy reports "nothing new." The BCBC clothing store will be open again in spring with the BCBC club design (more information on this elsewhere).

Vice President Linda had no updates.

Treasurer Alan provided the most recent financial report, including Shoo-Fly Classic financial report. The net income for the 2023 Shoo-Fly is \$1345.63. A donation will be made from this amount, to the township, to support recreational activities.. The club will be making annual donations of \$100.00 to Schuykill River Greenways, League of American Bicyclist, IMAble and Rails to Trails.

Membership Officer Kat reminded us that membership dues are due March 31. Membership runs April 1 through March 31.

Mileage Master Gary sent a report that states that he will tally end of the year mileage after he receives all sign-in sheets from ride hosts, he will also calculate ride hosts that will receive free membership.

Newsletter Coordinator Poncho reports that the newsletters are working out fine. We discussed discontinuing the print issue and providing ride schedule and highlights in printed form to bike shops, gyms, etc. It was decided to post this in newsletter and that the final printed

Webmaster Scott reports the website is in good shape. Shoo-Fly Coordinator Scott discussed a contract from Oley Fire Company of \$350 for use of fairgrounds for the 2024 Shoo-Fly Classic, Sat. Sept. 28.

**Discussion and Planning Items Bylaws Review:** The Bylaws Review is in progress. Poncho submitted a document for review with some suggestion to update current By Laws.

Randy questioned the goal of this review. Officers discussed the need to update and clarify parts of the Bylaws. Poncho suggested a committee be formed to update them. The full board of officers will vote on any amendments, and these must be submitted to the membership for approval, with the changes printed in the newsletter in time for the members to consider the changes. Several times over the past year the need to update current By-Laws has come up. For example, Walt requested we consider changing the title of "Advocacy & Trail Coordinator" this will be an item that the Bylaws Committee will

submit.

A ZOOM meeting specific to this discussion was scheduled for January 22. No changes will be implemented without a vote by the full board and the membership.

Winter Party/Banquet: Plans are underway for the 2024 winter party/banquet. Current plans include a March date, probably at Ozgood's in Robesonia. If members have other suggestions or would like to work on the planning for this event please contact one of the officers now.

Ride Schedule for 2024: BCBC will continue to offer short rides and long rides this season. We will also continue Matt's Adventure Rides and the Ramble Rides. We discussed hosting some "Special Fun Social Rides" this year, something we had done in the past. Examples include the Strawberry Festival Ride, Spring Thing Ride, and Christmas Lights Rides. If anyone would like to host or suggest a ride please let one of us know.

BCBC Jerseys: Randy will check current inventory. He would like to place an order, but he needs to know what is wanted (see more info elsewhere in newsletter). He anticipates ordering old and new design jerseys. Linda suggested this be set up as a direct order where members could go online and order themselves.

Meetings are scheduled for the second Monday of each month.

# A brief summary of bylaws update (continued from page 1)

Note: Our current bylaws, specifically Article XIII, dictate that any changes must be approved by the membership at a general meeting, and at least 10% of the membership must be present in order to vote on it. Also the notice of the changes must be published beforehand in the newsletter.

What are some of the changes being proposed for the bylaws?

1. Give standing committee chairpeople a vote on board decisions affecting their committee if they are not board members.

- 2. Change the status of most current standing committee chairpeople to official board officers.
- 3. Eliminate the Racing Division and change the Advocacy and Trail Liaison position to Media Liaison (The last is Walt H.'s idea. He is the current A&T Liaison.)
- 4. Change from Robert's Rules of Order to Modern Rules of Order, 5th edition. This is a widely used and preferred set of rules among non-profit groups.
- 5. Rewording needed in a number of places, for clarity's sake.

- 6. Specify that online meetings will be considered official and proper.
- 7. Will voting by email or phone be allowed? In what circumstances? Member input is welcome.


